- Obtain a letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, or school administrator.

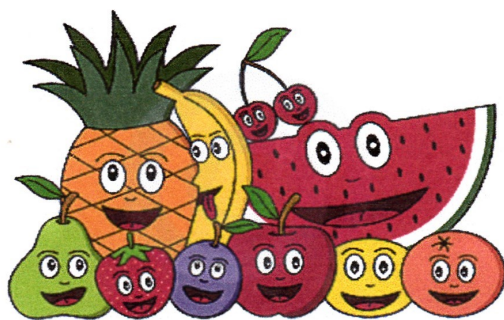
